

LA Police Protective League Funding for Traci Park

Summary

The LAPPL has directed **\$1,728,760.41** in total spending to support Traci Park across the 2022 and 2026 City Council races.

Note on double-counting: In 2022, the LAPPL PAC contributed \$400,000 in monetary funds and \$1,688.28 in non-monetary (consulting) services into the LAPPL-sponsored IE committee. That IE committee then spent \$1,232,641.45 on communications supporting Park. The contributions are the source of funding for the IE committee — counting both would double-count the same money. The IE spending total is the correct measure of how much police-backed money was actually deployed to support Park. The LAPPL contributions into the IE committee are itemized separately below for transparency.

All funding originates from **Los Angeles Police Protective League (LAPPL)** entities. Individual police officer donations excluded.

Methodology

- **Independent Expenditures** queried from the Ethics Commission API, linked to Form 57 and Form 496 filings.
- **Contributions** queried from LA Ethics Commission Socrata dataset m6g2-gc6c (City Campaign Contributions), matched to filing PDFs via br3a-db9a (Campaign Statements Filed).
- The 2022 LAPPL contributions flowed into the LAPPL-sponsored IE committee. To avoid double-counting, only the IE spending (the actual deployment of funds supporting Park) is included in the grand total. The contributions are listed for transparency to show the funding chain.
- Filtered to donors/filers with "police protective league" or "police" in organization name. Individual police officer donations excluded.
- All amounts and links verified against production database as of March 20, 2026.
